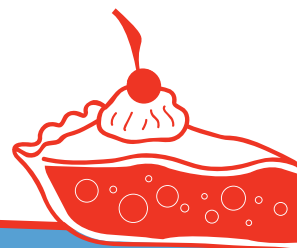

We know you'll enjoy our house-made ice creams in dazzling flavors by Chef John Besh, along with snazzy sandwiches, soups and other treats. Breakfast, too! We're especially proud that our spinning soda stools come from New Orleans' historic Krauss department store.

The first soda fountain with counter service opened in 1903 and, soon, these new establishments became popular gathering spots across America. In the 1920s, they were even hailed as a greater ally for the temperance movement than all the sermons preached for the cause! By the 1930s and 40s, soda fountains were enjoyed by all ages and were especially popular teen hangouts, immortalized in Archie comic books and in the classic song *Juke Box Saturday Night*
