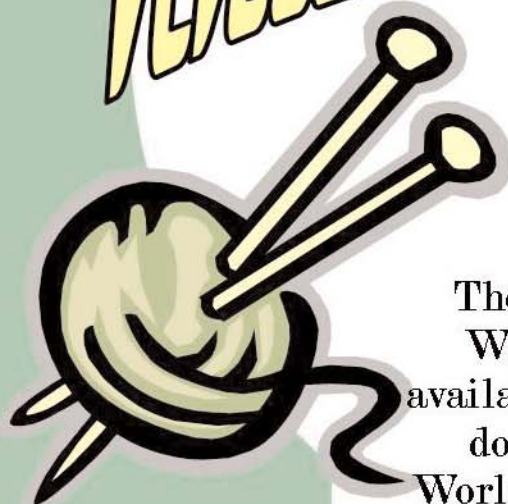


Knit your Bit!
