How to Make a Reservation



Don't You Know There's A War On? is designed for students in grades 2-4. Class size must be between 10 and 30 students. At least one teacher or chaperone per 10 students is required; one chaperone per 5 students is admitted free; additional chaperones \$8. The program costs \$4 per student (\$5 in March, April, and May). The program lasts approximately 1½ hours. Groups may arrange to visit the Museum after the program at no additional charge.

Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance and are subject to availability. The program is offered Tuesday through Friday.
