## **Executive Summary:**

It is of utmost importance that The National World War II Museum maintains its relevance and keeps its programs fresh and exciting through presentations of major new exhibitions for our visitors and constituents. The Special Exhibits Gallery will enable us to interpret many topics of the American World War II experience not covered in the existing permanent exhibits, to display the breadth and depth of the collection, and to portray and address causes of war and peace through the ages. Additionally, the Special Exhibits Gallery will meet the square footage requirements of premier traveling exhibits from other museums and institutions. In this way, The National World War II Museum will fulfill the expectations of its visitors with the stories and artifacts which make our museum unique among educational institutions.

The 6,500 square foot Special Exhibits Gallery will be a flexible, multi-functional space capable of hosting up to two special exhibits at any time. Related programming events such as book signings or host receptions can be accommodated in a VIP space immediately adjacent to the Gallery. The combined space will be available for rentals and have direct access to Magazine Street and our planned parking facility.
