Lunch Options: Please contact Group Sales to pre-purchase box lunches. Box lunches may be purchased to “dine-in” or “to go.” Groups are welcome to bring sack lunches; however sack lunches cannot be eaten indoors. Outdoor space on the Museum campus is limited and weather dependent. Groups may also bring sack lunches to nearby green space or eat on the bus.

Drop-off and Parking: The bus loading and unloading lane is adjacent to the Museum at 945 Magazine Street. Bus parking is available two blocks away under the Interstate overpass, using the parking pass provided upon arrival by our Security.

- Students must use quiet voices. Loud talking and yelling is disruptive to other visitors.

- Students MUST be accompanied by a designated chaperone at all times.
