

National World War II Museum V for Victory Scarf Pattern

***** CROCHET *****

Materials: Crochet hook size : H
Yarn: Red Heart Soft Yarn, E278, 4420 Guacamole, 1 skein

Pattern:

Chain: 25

Row 1: dc in 3rd chain from hook and each remaining ch. DC 23

Tip- use a hook slightly larger (approx. size H) to do initial chain, this will keep it from curling.

Row 2: ch 2 at turn (this counts as the DC at the beginning of each new row) dc in each dc across (dc 23)

For V:

Row 3: dc 10, ch 3, cont. dc 10 more, turn

Row 4: dc 9, ch 2, dc 1, ch 2, dc 9

Row 5: dc 8, ch 2, dc 3, ch 2, dc 8

Row 6: dc 7, ch 2, dc 5, ch 2, dc 7

Row 7: dc 6, ch 2, dc 7, ch 2, dc 6

Row 8: dc 5, ch 2, dc 9, ch 2, dc 5

Row 9: dc 4, ch 2, dc 11, ch 2, dc 4

Row 10: dc 3, ch 2, dc 13, ch 2, dc 3

Row 11: dc 2, ch 4, dc 11, ch 4, dc 2

Row 12 →: dc 23, turn (ch 2) repeat until desired length. Approx. 52 rows



**Reverse:
Opposite V**

We will call this row 53:

Row 53: dc 2, ch 4, dc 11, ch 4, dc 2

Row 54: dc 3, ch 2, dc 13, ch 2, dc 3

Row 55: dc 4, ch 2, dc 11, ch 2, dc 4

Row 56: dc 5, ch 2, dc 9, ch 2, dc 5

Row 57: dc 6, ch 2, dc 7, ch 2, dc 6

Row 58: dc 7, ch 2, dc 5, ch 2, dc 7

Row 59: dc 8, ch 2, dc 3, ch 2, dc 8

Row 60: dc 9, ch 2, dc 1, ch 2, dc 9

Row 61: dc 10, ch 3, cont. dc 10 more, turn

Row 62 and 63 →: dc 23 for 2 more rows
