National World War II Museum V for Victory Scarf Pattern

Materials: (*yarn is suggested based on this pattern, you may use other yarn, just adapt stitch count according to weight and bulkiness of yarn chosen*) 1 skein worsted weight yarn sz 8 US needles

Gauge 6st per inch

Cast on 36 st (or approx 6") Knit 5 rows in garter stitch

Row 1: knit Row 2: k5, p26, k5 Repeat * until there are 10 rows stockinette stitch

For the V:

Row 3 (RS): k5, k12, p2, k12, k5 Rows 4-24: k5, knit the knits, purl the purls, k5 Row 5: k5, k11, p4, k11, k5 Row 7: k5, k10, p6, k10, k5 Row 9: k5, k9, p8, k9, k5 Row 11: k5, k8, p4, k2, p4, k8, k5 Row 13: k5, k7, p4, k4, p4, k7, k5 Row 15: k5, k6, p4, k6, p4, k6, k5 Rows 17 & 19: k5, k5, p4, k8, p4, k5, k5* Rows 21 & 23: k5, k3, p8, k4, p8, k3, k5*



Continue Rows 1 & 2 until you are approximately six inches from desired end length.

REVERSE V pattern starting with row 23

Rows 1 & 2 for 10 rows Knit 5 rows in garter stitch BO all stitches
