The National WWII Museum Knit Your Bit Seaman's Cabled Scarf Pattern

Size: Approx 7" x 48"

Materials: Size 10 US (6mm) needles 1 skein worsted weight wool (250 yards)

Stitch Abbreviation:

C12F (Cable 12 front): Slip 6 sts to the cable needle and hold in front of work. Knit next 6 sts from left needle, then k6 from cable needle.

Instructions

CO 32

MOSS STITCH BASE

R1: *k1, p1 rep from * to end of row R2: *p1, k1 rep from * to end of row Repeat Rows 1 and 2.

CABLE PATTERN

R1:, *k1, p1 rep from *, p6, k12, p6, *k1, p1 rep from *
R2: *p1, k1 rep from *, k6, p12, k6, *p1, k1 rep from *
R3 – R8: Repeat Rows 1 & 2
R9: *k1, p1 rep from *, p6, C12F, p6, *k1, p1 rep from *
R10: Repeat Row 2
Repeat Rows 1-10 until scarf measures 18"
End with even numbered row.

RIBBED CENTER SECTION OF SCARF

R1: (RS) *k2, p2 rep from * to end of row Repeat Row 1 until ribbed pattern measures 12", end with WS row

CABLE PATTERN, Side 2

Repeat 10 row cable pattern above until second cabled part is 17", ending with even numbered row.

Finish with 4 rows moss stitch base
