Known as "France's Breadbasket" for its rich bounty of dairy and grain products, Normandy, France, is perhaps better known today as the site of D-Day, one of the most pivotal battles in history. Upon landing, Allied servicemembers were almost immediately greeted by the local Normans who provided valuable enemy intelligence, food and drink, and a warm camaraderie that still exists today.
