2025 Robot Game Table Set Up Instructions

The National WWII Museum's Robotics Competition uses a 4ft x 8ft table with raised edges. The right edge of the mat aligns with the right edge of the table, leaving 12 inches of free space to the left of the mat. Each Practice Kit contain the items needed to set up the 2025 Robot Game. Please refer to the information contained in this document as you set up your mat and mission models for the game. Please email any questions to robotics@nationalww2museum.org

Before you begin:

 Yellow X's mark the locations that Velcro tape should be placed on the mat. Please remove the backing of the Velcro found on your materials and place it in

Robot Game Mission Set Up:

- **1. Draft Letter** Remove the Velcro backing from the back of the envelope. Place the closed draft letter envelope in the rectangle.
- **2. Building Victory** No set up required. The blocks should be brought to their destination from HQ.
- 3. SS Sea Cloud Place the boat with the nose facing left.
- **4.** Red Ball Express Place the car in the red box.
- **5. Protest Banner** Remove the backing from the two pieces of Velcro tape to attach the handkerchief to the lined rectangle on the mat. Fold the handkerchief vertically down the middle.
- **6. 6888th Battalion** No set up required. The bean bags should be brought to their destination from HQ.
- 7. Black Rosies Remove the backing from the Velcro tape. Place the dowel inside the red circle.

 The wooden rings will be brought from HQ during the game
- **8. Blood Plasma** Place the plasma cannister in the circle inside the black box.
- 9. Tuskegee Airmen Remove the parts of the plane from its packaging. Put the wings and rudders into the slots on the body of the plane. Add the plastic piece to the nose of the plane. Place the airplane in the box with diagonal lines.
